TLC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Met with OACTE and started mapping out how to blend both TLC and Oregon DATA Project Key Concepts into existing course offerings. Western University is tentatively targeting a fall 2010 gradual implementation of this work into existing courses. • Presented at the Title I conference on TLC & the Oregon DATA Project. The session was well attended with over 70 participants. DATA Project	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Performance coach training wrapped-up for ESD staff. Oregon has 17 certified coaches who are skilled at guiding districts on a focused course of improvement. • PSU has a summer class scheduled for administrators on Strand 1, 2 & 3 Key concepts. Carol Middleton from Clackamas ESD will be co-teaching that class with PSU staff. • Approximately 30 districts have e-mailed or phoned about receiving additional support through project efforts. • On-line registration for administrators and teachers is now available through PSU allowing 2 credit hours to be earned for each school year work being done through the project. • The first state-wide WebEx was sponsored featuring “implementation & sustainability” efforts from Clackamas ESD. Over 100 participants attended. Thank you to Doug for getting this piece taken care of. Once HDES has the dollars the recipients will be able to bill HDESD for their award and have the money transferred to them. I would expect that this would begin happening later in February or early March.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • KIDS/DATA 	<p>Have arranged for a meeting and sharing opportunity for the 6 regional data warehouse providers to come together later this month, Feb. 25. This will be an opportunity for all regional's to share and learn from each other and will allow us all to gain some insights into where each of the warehouses are at in their development and implementation. This will serve as the first <i>Sustainability</i> project/report that I will be taking on. There will be a complete report that is shared around the state and placed on the EESC website. After this initial report I will be conducting quarterly surveys with each of the regional providers as well as with ODE to provide status updates to the field.</p> <p>Have been involved with all of the meetings and discussions around a governance committee that is being formed in partnership between ODE and the regional providers. This governance committee will help to shape and guide the current and future work in the partnership between the regional warehouses and ODE.</p> <p>Have been having weekly meetings with Josh Klein and Joel Robe at ODE to update them with information and feedback I am getting from the field as I travel and work with people around the state.</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Bandwidth	<p>Created a bandwidth guidance committee for the web application being built to track bandwidth K-12 in the state. Members are: Russell Rubrecht – LESD, Scott Voll- WESD, Tom Hutchison – UMESD, Israel Mathewson – SOESD, Jeremy Pietzol – CESD and myself.</p> <p>This group will have its first meeting in March to finalize the Phase I tasks of the application. Once this is finalized we will open the application for the updating of information around bandwidth in the state. The group will meet quarterly to approve and prioritize features and developments of the different phases of the application.</p> <p>I am currently trying to make contact and get more information about the FCC bandwidth-mapping project. Want to see where our efforts can support one another and avoid any duplication of effort.</p>
